## IMPORTANT INFORMATION for NOMINATING A DIRECTOR

When nominating a director please be aware that the following could disqualify your nominee from managing corporations if they:

- have been convicted of an offence under the Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006 (CATSI Act) that is punishable by imprisonment for more than 12 months
- have been convicted of an offence involving dishonesty that is punishable by imprisonment for at least three
  months
- have been convicted of an offence against the law of a foreign country that is punishable by imprisonment for more than 12 months
- is an undischarged bankrupt
- have signed a personal insolvency agreement and have not kept to the agreement
- have been disqualified under the Corporations Act 2001 from managing corporations,

and they will be required to notify the corporation if any of the above events occur after their appointment.

NOTE: This form should be completed and given to the corporation before the person is appointed as a director—section 246-10(1) of the CATSI Act.

#### **CATSI Act**

### Extracted from the CATSI Act

### 246-10 Consent to act as director

An Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander corporation contravenes this subsection if a
person does not give the corporation a signed consent to act as a director of the
corporation before being appointed.

Penalty: 10 penalty units.

(2) The corporation must keep the consent.

Penalty: 5 penalty units.

(3) An offence against subsection (1) or (2) is an offence of strict liability

Note: For strict liability, see section 6.1 of the Criminal Code.

## The period of automatic disqualification is set out in sections 279-5 and 279-10 of the CATSI Act.

(5) A person is disqualified from managing Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander corporations at a particular time if the person is, at that time, disqualified from managing Corporations Act corporations under Part 2D.6 of the Corporations Act.

#### 279-10 Extension of period of automatic disqualification

- (1) This section applies if:
  - (a) under subsection 279-5(1); or
  - (b) as a result of the operation of subsection 206B(1) of the Corporations Act and subsection 279-5(5) of this Act;
  - a person is disqualified from managing Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander corporations on being convicted of an offence.
- (2) On application by the Registrar, the Court may extend by up to an additional 15 years the period of disqualification.
- (3) The Registrar must apply:
  - (a) before the period of disqualification begins; or
  - (b) before the end of the first year of the disqualification.
- (4) The Registrar may apply only once in relation to the disqualification.
- (5) In determining whether an extension is justified (and if so, for how long), the Court may have regard to any matters that the Court considers appropriate.
